Tips:

Reference works, newspapers and journals are not available for loan. If a patron needs to borrow such an item for a particular and acceptable reason, he/she can have it on loan only for 24 hours. Borrowing of such an item can only be processed at the Service Desk.

#### 2. Renewal

A patron can renew a borrowed item before it is due, and by doing so you can keep the item for an additional loan period. However, if the loan period reaches its maximum, or if the borrowed item is on call, you cannot have the item renewed.



CD/VCD, audio-video materials, course reserves and JD Read are not for renewable.

### 3. Request

You can request an item if it is out on loan. A message will be sent to you when the item comes back to the library and is ready for you to pick up at the Service Desk or 24-Hour Self-service Pick-up Book Cabinet by presenting the message. The library will keep the item for a maximum of three days.

#### 4. Overdue Fine

When a book is overdue, the overdue fines will be charged (at a rate of RMB 0.2 yuan per item per day), but the patron's borrowing privilege will not be suspended. It will be suspended only when the overdue fines accrue to 10 yuan, and privilege will be resumed only when overdue items are returned and the payment of fines is made.

## 5. Items Damaged or Loss

Patrons should protect the library collection from damage or loss; otherwise different types of penalties will occur.



### 1. Patron's Card Service

Your University Card (UC) can also function as your library card, but it has to be authenticated before you use it to borrow books or other materials from the library.

- ➤ UC for new students is automatically authenticated for library loans.

  Faculty and staff can bring UC to the Service Desk for authentication.
- ➤ Writing-off of the UC can only be processed after patrons return all the items on the card when they leave the university.
- ➤ Service Hours: Yidan Library: Monday to Sunday: 8:30-22:00 Lynn Library: Monday to Friday: 8:30-12:00;14:00-17:30 except National Holidays and winter/summer vacations.

#### 2. Recommend a Purchasd

- ➤ Patrons are welcomed to recommend a book, a journal or other information resources that are not available in the library's collection.
- To make a recommendation, please visit the library website and fill out the form of "Recommend a Purchase" under "Collections"; or email at lib\_acq@sustech.edu.cn.

## 3. Interlibrary Loan / Document Delivery

- Our library will obtain a document (a book, an article or some other material) from other libraries at the request of a patron when he/she cannot find it at our own library.
- ➤ Patrons can apply for Interlibrary Loan/Document Delivery online via the library website, or send document request to lib\_ill@sustech.edu.cn.
- ➤ Our library will request document (a book, an article or some other material) from other libraries at the request of a patron and send the



- electronic document to the patron, or inform the patron to collect the printed document at the Service Desk.
- ➤ The library will provide a subsidy of RMB 500 per person per year for the cost of Interlibrary Loan/Document Delivery. No subsidy will be provided for the excess amount.

## 4. Information Literacy Education

# **III. Library Collection**

As of December 2023, the library has a total of 292,617 Chinese and foreign volumes of books (216,350 in Chinese and 76,267 in foreign languages), 65 titles of Chinese newspapers and periodicals, and 24 titles of foreign language newspapers and periodicals. There are 136 Chinese and foreign language databases (27 Chinese and 109 foreign languages), including 704,829 e-books and 78,206 e-journals.

# **IV. Functional Areas and Facilities**

There are three libraries on SUSTech campus. Lynn Library, a three-story building of 10,000 square meters, was made available for public use in September 2013. Yidan Library, opened in December 2020, is a building with a total area of 9,010 square meters. The Learning Nexus, a building of 1,200 square meters, opened in November 2020. Each library provides diversified spaces conducive to learning in various forms including leisure zone, quiet study zone, collaborative learning space, computer hub, group study room, classroom, studio and auditorium.
