Fruits have long been a staple in human diets across the globe and continue to be a popular food choice. In an essay, select a fruit and explore the various factors that contribute to that fruit's popularity.

Apples

Apples are a fruit that are a very popular choice in Australia, because of their availability all year round, their relatively low cost to the consumer, and their sweet taste amongst many different varieties available to eat. Apples are also a nutrient dense food and are a fantastic option for those looking to improve their health while still being able to eat sweet foods.

While apples are typically picked during the harvest months of January to June, apples are usually available for purchase in Australia all year round. This is due to the fact that apples can be stored in special environments that can slow and even prevent the ripening process. This special environment takes advantage of a technology called Controlled Atmosphere storage, where "the temperature, oxygen, carbon dioxide, and humidity levels are adjusted to form long-term storage environments for apples being stored after harvest" (Graham, 2020). This process of Controlled Atmosphere storage, enables apples to be enjoyed all year round, and as such are one of the most commonly eaten fruit in Australia.

Apples are a relatively cheap food source, and are comparatively so to other fruit available on the supermarket shelves. Apple varieties at major supermarkets are being sold at between \$4 to \$7 a kilo, making them popular with shoppers, and retail data

How to calculate Similarity?
