Quick Submit

- The quick submit feature allows instructors to submit papers and receive Similarity Reports without creating a class or an assignment.
- Quick submit should not be used if the instructor desires to have students submit their own papers or plans on using features including Peer Review, GradeMark, or GradeBook.
- Please Note: Quick Submit will be changing to eliminate bulk upload, ensure no translated matching is applied, and possibly cap number of submissions on a daily/weekly/monthly basis.





An adult blue whale can eat up to 40 million krill in a day.[48] The whales always feed in the areas with the highest concentration of krill, sometimes eating up to 3,600 kilograms (7,900 lb) of krill in a single day.[41] The daily energy requirement of an adult blue whale is estimated to be 100 million kilocalories. Blue whales feed almost exclusively on krill, though they also take small numbers of copepods. An adult blue whale can eat up to 40 million krill in a day.
